REGISTER WITH THE COLLEGE

Register with the College when you receive an email from the Registration Office

- ✓ You can also register with the College from your home country before you arrive in Ireland.
- ✓ You will get your Griffith College **Student Card** in September.

OPEN AN IRISH BANK ACCOUNT

- Once you've registered, you will be able to order a Bank Letter from the International Office to open your bank account.
- ✓ If you open a mobile/virtual bank account you don't need a letter!

GET A LEAP CARD (STUDENT TRAVEL CARD)

The Leap Card saves students money on public transport services as well as selected retail brands.

NON-EU STUDENTS: REGISTER WITH THE IRISH IMMIGRATION SERVICE - ISD (Formerly know as "GNIB" and "INIS")

Non-EU students are required to register with the Irish Immigration Service, normally within 90 days of their arrival in Ireland.

GET A PPS NUMBER (IRISH SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER)

It is a requirement for all graduating students to have a PPS Number, and you also need it if you want to get a part-time job in Ireland.

IMPORTANT! YOU CAN'T APPLY FOR A PPS NUMBER UNTIL YOU HAVE REGISTERED WITH IRISH IMMIGRATION
