Host family Policy

The purpose of this policy is to outline the procedures and standards for placing students with host families, ensuring a safe, welcoming, and culturally enriching experience that supports the academic and personal goals of our students.

Staying with a host family provides:

- A safe, comfortable, and supportive home environment.
- Promotes cultural exchange and English language practice.

All host families must:

- Provide a clean, private room with adequate storage and study space.
- Provide breakfast and dinner (half-board) during the week, and three meals on weekends.
- Integrate the student into family life and provide a supportive atmosphere.
- Notify the school of any issues or changes in circumstances that may affect the student.
- All host families must sign a host family agreement

Students are placed based on:

- Age, gender, dietary needs, allergies, and medical conditions.
- Language background (to promote English use at home).
- Preferences regarding pets, children, or smoking.
- Availability and proximity to the school
