



# Higher Diploma in Computing

## Non-EU students **living in Ireland**

Non-EU students already living in Ireland who enrol in the 2-year pathway programme are eligible for a **50% scholarship** for the Higher Diploma in Computing (Year 1). This scholarship is designed to support students who are already established within Ireland’s residency and administrative systems, enabling a seamless commencement of studies and a clear progression pathway toward postgraduate education.

### EXAMPLE OF THE FEE STRUCTURE:

## Non-EU students **living abroad**

Non-EU students applying from abroad who enrol in the 2-year pathway programme will receive a **50% scholarship on the master’s programme** (Year 2). This scholarship model is designed to support international students once they have fully settled in Ireland, following their initial relocation and integration into the Irish education system. Offering the scholarship in Year 2 promotes continued academic progression, supports long-term study planning, and facilitates a smooth transition into advanced postgraduate study.
