The Griffith Global Excellence Scholarship

Available for all learners applying from outside Ireland for full-time bachelors and masters programmes at Griffith College's Dublin, Cork or Limerick campuses.

The **Griffith Global Excellence Scholarship (GGES)** will offer a limited number of students who have secured excellent grades in both their academic studies and English language proficiency.

Students who require a visa to study in Ireland will be subject to all normal visa requirements and visa decisions are solely at the discretion of the relevant Government of Ireland authorities.

Scholarship provided:

- **Non-EU:** 50% tuition fee scholarship
- **EU:** 25% tuition fee scholarship

Successful applicants must be able to pay their remaining tuition fees and living expenses while studying in Ireland.

All GGES applications will be evaluated by the GGES Scholarship Committee and based on:

- 1 CGPA / Grades
- 2 English Language Proficiency
- 3 Any other programme entry requirements e.g. portfolio, interview, etc.
- 4 Statement of Purpose

There are limited seats available. These seats will be allocated on a first come first served basis and secured by a deposit/full fee payment.

Application documents required

Passport, CV, transcript of results (original and translated), proof of graduation (original and translated), IELTS marksheets, statement of purpose, and any other programme entry requirements.
