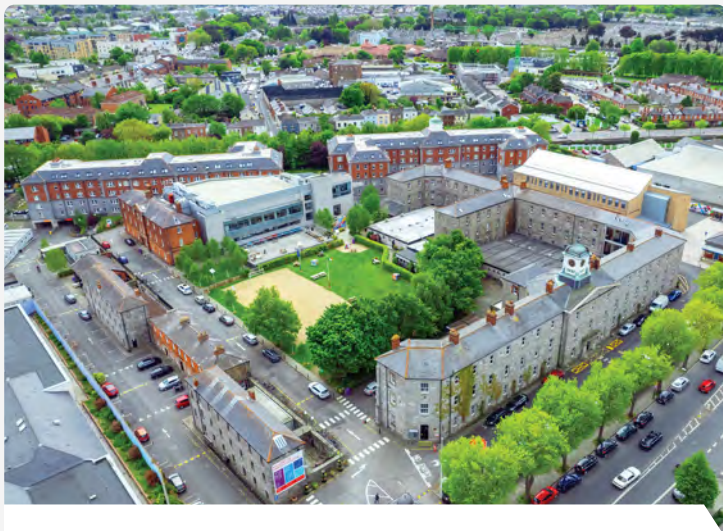

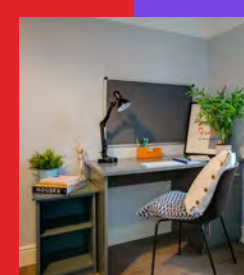
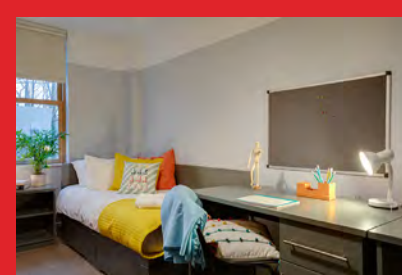

INTERNATIONALLY RECOGNISED QUALIFICATION

Whether you choose to build your career in Ireland or elsewhere in the world, your internationally recognised Griffith College qualification gives you the knowledge and practical skills to move forward with confidence.

GRADUATE STAY BACK VISA (STAMP 1G)

International graduates who successfully complete a Master's degree at Griffith College are eligible to remain in Ireland for up to two years under the Third Level Graduate Programme (Stamp 1G). This permission allows graduates to work full-time and gain valuable international experience. Graduates who secure employment in an eligible occupation may transition to a Critical Skills Employment Permit.

TAKE YOUR GRIFFITH COLLEGE EXPERIENCE GLOBAL

GLOBAL NETWORK:

Ireland hosts the European headquarters of many multinational companies in technology, pharmaceuticals, life sciences, financial services, and creative media.

Graduates who gain valuable experience in Ireland can tap into these global networks as their careers progress.

GLOBAL SKILLS:

Ireland is the largest English-speaking country in the EU and attracts many multinational companies.
