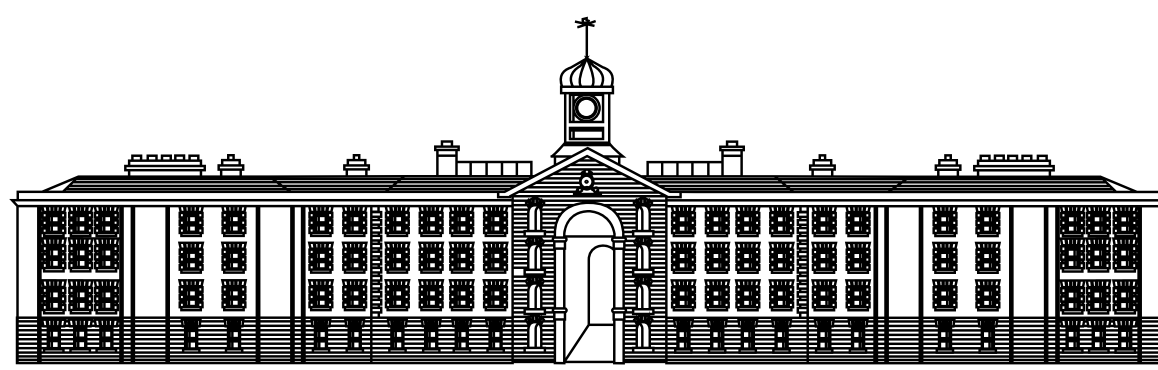

**A.I.P fees are reviewed annually and are charged at the beginning of each academic year)*
Note for Students commencing in the Spring (February) intake: An Academic Administration Fee of €250 and an International Student Support Fee of €300 will be charged every September for all students regardless of status. The Protection of Enrolled Learner Fee is only paid once per stage (or repeated stage).

Sibling Discount

A **10% Sibling Discount** is available to a second and any subsequent sibling enrolling as an international student at Griffith College. The discount applies to net tuition fees after scholarships and bursaries. If the first sibling is still enrolled, they will also receive the discount on future registrations.

AMS Level 1	€1,000 70%+ average in highest level of education to date or IELTS 5.5/ DET 95-100
AMS Level 2	€1,500 80%+ average in highest level of education to date or IELTS 6.0/ DET 105-115
AMS Level 3	€2,000 90%+ average in highest level of education to date or IELTS 6.5/ DET 120-125

Where certified proof of English language ability is not an admissions requirement, other academic grades will be considered

AMS Exceptions

The following programmes are NOT eligible for Academic Merit Scholarship:

- BA (Hons) in Music Production
- BA (Hons) in Music Production with Composition
- BA (Hons) in Audio and Music Technology
- BA (Hons) in Game Design and Development
- BA (Ord) in Animation
- Certificate in Animation

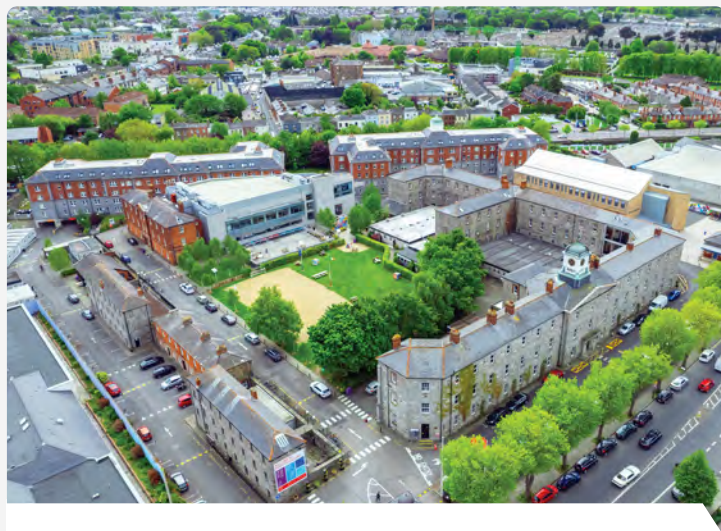

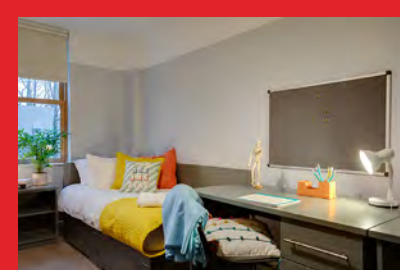
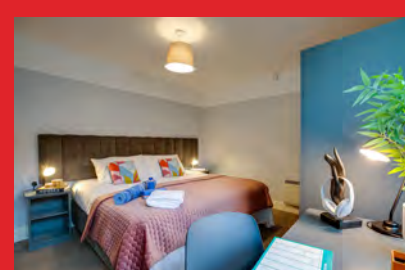

INTERNATIONALLY RECOGNISED QUALIFICATION

Whether you choose to build your career in Ireland or elsewhere in the world, your internationally recognised Griffith College qualification gives you the knowledge and practical skills to move forward with confidence.

GRADUATE STAY BACK VISA (STAMP 1G)

International graduates who successfully complete an Honours Bachelor's degree at Griffith College are eligible to remain in Ireland for up to one year under the Third Level Graduate Programme (Stamp 1G). This permission allows graduates to work full-time and gain valuable international experience. Graduates who secure employment in an eligible occupation may transition to a Critical Skills Employment Permit.

GLOBAL SKILLS:

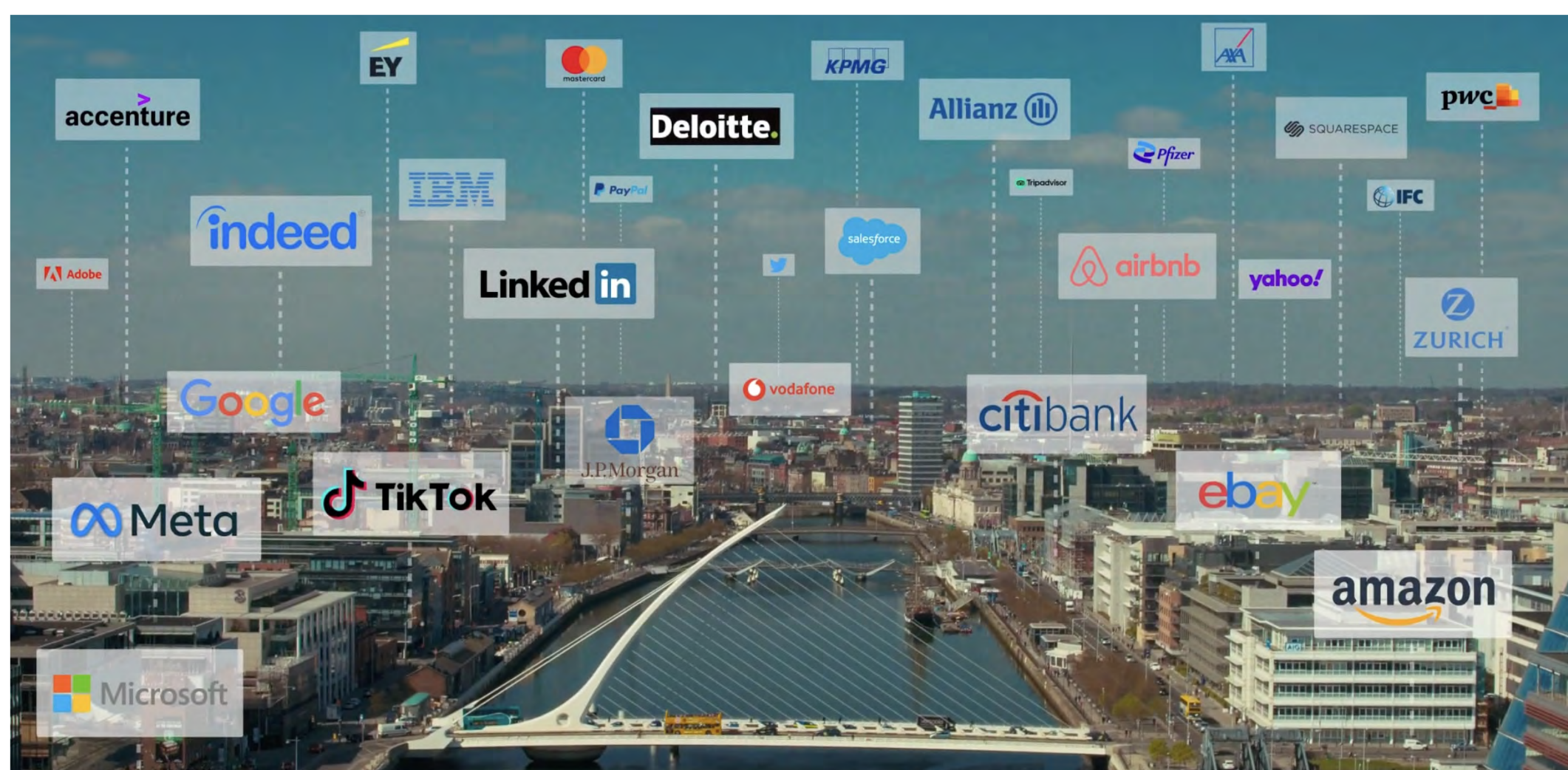
Ireland is the largest English-speaking country in the EU and attracts many multinational companies.

GLOBAL LEADER IN EDUCATION:

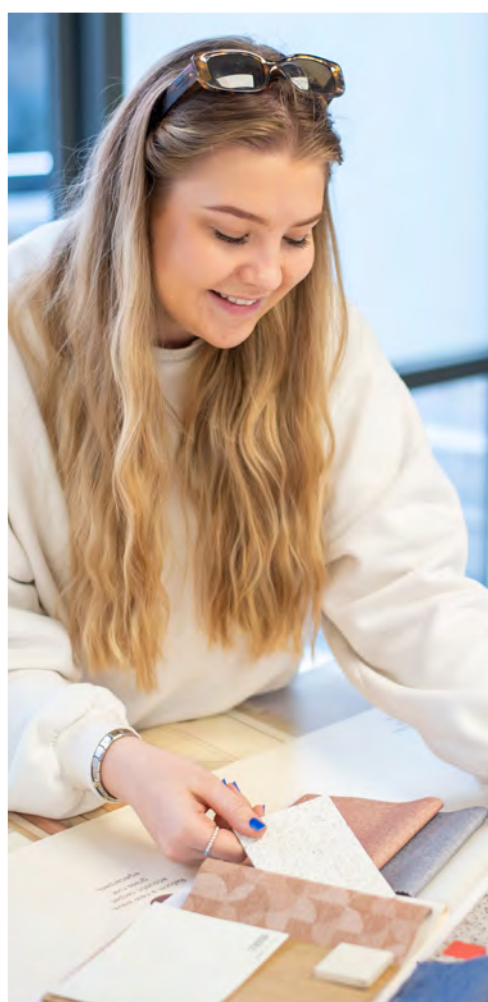
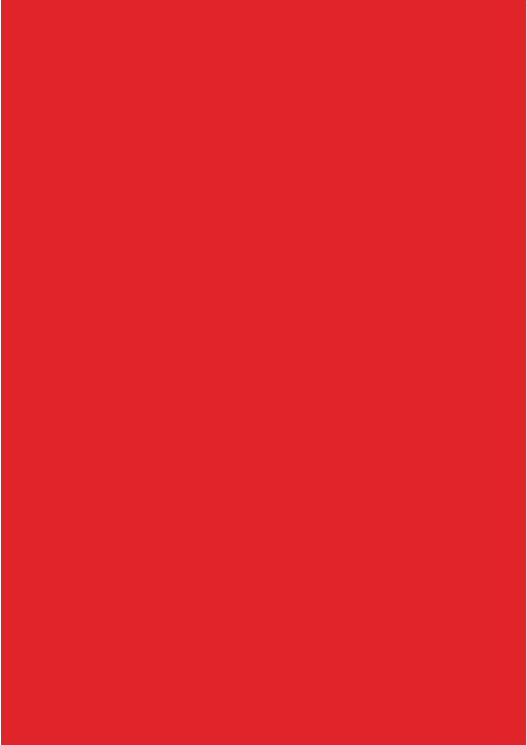
