

Griffith College's key update

As Ireland is currently in level 5 COVID-19 restrictions, to keep everyone safe, the College will be following government requirements for higher education by delivering the remainder of semester 1 as much as possible online.

This means that faculties will deliver their lectures online without on-campus attendance.

Teaching schedules will not be altered with classes taking place at the same time as previously scheduled. If your programme has specific additional requirements, your faculty will contact you directly.

Special Notice for Week Commencing Monday 4th January to Friday 8th January

For the week of January 4th to January 8th, classes requiring labs, practical or studio sessions will be deferred so that lecturers and learners are not required to attend the campus.

Your faculty will be in touch soon regarding the rescheduling of any such sessions and any related submission dates.

Online lectures will continue to be delivered during the week of January 4th to January 8th as originally scheduled.

Learners wishing to access labs and studios to advance their studies during this first week of 2021 may continue to do so in accordance with agreed booking procedures and the college's established COVID-19 safety procedures.
