

Griffith College's key update

As Ireland is currently in level 5 COVID-19 restrictions, to keep everyone safe, the College will be following government requirements for higher education by delivering the vast majority of teaching online.

This means that faculties will deliver their lectures online without on-campus attendance. Teaching schedules will not be altered with classes taking place at the same time as previously scheduled. If your programme has specific additional requirements, your faculty will contact you directly.

- The current “level 5 plus” measures are in place until Friday 5th March 2021, where primary and secondary schools are closed and we have additional restrictions. Only very limited and pre-agreed teaching will take place on campus.
- Level 5 & 4 will allow for a return to the measures we had in November 2020, with practical classes held on campus and other very limited and pre-agreed teaching also taking place on campus. The remainder of teaching will remain online. Your Head of Faculty will provide further guidance and clarification.
- Level 3 will allow for all programmes to be delivered in a hybrid/dual-delivery mode. In-person teaching to learners in all faculties may resume. Lecturers will deliver their online and hybrid lectures from their lecture rooms (i.e., not off-campus), as per the planned faculty timetable.
