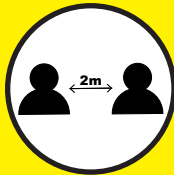




COVID-19 STUDENT GUIDE

Campus Health and Safety

How To Protect Yourself And Others On Campus



Maintain a social distance from others



Wash your hands regularly and use the hand sanitisers provided



Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue / sleeve when coughing or sneezing



Wearing a face-covering while on campus is mandatory



You may remove your face-covering only when outside or when seated at your classroom desk



Do not touch your eyes, nose or mouth with unwashed hands



Do not shake hands or hug each other



Do not touch unnecessary surfaces



Ventilate classrooms by opening the windows where possible



Avoid in-person meetings, Zoom meetings are preferred



Avoid public transport where possible or travel in off-peak hours



Do not share paper documents and stationary with classmates
