### **Intended Module Learning Outcomes**

On successful completion of this module, learners will be able to:

1. Design and present comprehensive plans for training and educational programmes.
2. Critique programmes (on going) in order to inform advanced professional practice in education and training management.
3. Utilise a range of tools to design and evaluate training and educational programmes (e.g. cost benefit analysis; TNA).
4. Act as a business partner and change agent; demonstrating the ability to link strategic business drivers, and organisational culture to work based learning.
5. Demonstrate competency in the tendering process.
6. Apply a range of specialised workplace coaching & mentoring skills and tools.

### **Module Objectives**

The Professional Practice and Management module embraces a diverse range of objectives. These objectives provide learners with the opportunity to evaluate cultural and social factors, which impact on teaching, training, learning and assessment, and to promote an inclusive and productive training and educational environment. It additionally allows learners to critically evaluate training and teaching within a professional context and to examine the cost benefit analysis for such education and training initiatives.

This module also determines various modes of learning technologies that support a range of educational and training contexts, and support learners in the application of advanced research skills within the professional context of education and training.

Finally, it provides learners with the supports to develop their professional practice through developing their professional communication and influencing skills, advanced competency in the tendering process and the insurance and corporate requirements of professional practice.
