Job Summary:

Griffith College is in partnership with two Universities in China, Hebei Finance University & Hunan University of Commerce. We are looking for an experienced professional to teach English language with a focus on both general English for academic purposes and also an element of Irish Culture. The purpose of teaching this course is to prepare students for degree level study in Ireland, give students an understanding of Irish culture with the opportunity to practice their spoken English and to improve their English language skills.

Job Responsibilities:

- To teach English Language with a focus on both general English & English for academic purposes.
- To give students an understanding of Irish culture with the opportunity to practice their spoken English and improve their overall English language skills.
- To assist students in achieving the required English language level for studying academic courses in Ireland.
- To teach the English language programme in line with the Griffith College syllabus.
- Teach approximately 20 teaching hours (50 minutes classes) per week.
- Any other duties that fall within the employee's capabilities.

Minimum Education/ Experience Requirements:

- Candidates must be educated to at least level 8 degree and have an appropriate 120hr TEFL certificate
- The successful candidate will be open-minded to other cultures.
- An understanding of Irish culture and respect for different cultures is essential.
- Minimum of two years of teaching experience required.
- The successful candidate will be required to undergo medical assessment and Garda vetting for visa purposes. The cost of which will be reimbursed by the college.

Other points to note:

- Teachers will be visited each semester by line managers from Griffith College
- One return flight will be provided between Ireland and China.
- Accommodation on campus will be provided. The cost of rent and utility bills will be covered.



Holidays

- The winter holiday period is from the middle of January to late February and the summer holiday period is from early July to late August. Annual leave will need to be taken during these periods.
- Entitlement to the same public holidays as Chinese citizens. This includes New Year's Day, Spring Festival, Qingming Festival, International Labour Day, Duanwu Festival, Chinese National Day, Mid-autumn Festival and other holidays designated by law and regulations.

Salary:

- Salary commensurate with experience
- Additional to Griffith College salary there will be a monthly living expense from the partner university of approximately €1,000.
