Job Summary:

The successful candidate will gain exposure to a wide range of eLearning tools and platforms, supporting online and blended learning activity on many and varied programmes. Reporting to the Learning Technologist Manager (Head of DLD) they will have individual responsibility for developing high quality training guides and helping develop digital content across multiple disciplines. Working to maximise student-centred learning and engagement, liaising with programme teams and supporting all Griffith academic staff, this challenging role involves roll-out of emergent technologies in various modes, from our high-quality classroom delivery, to blended and online programmes.

Job Responsibilities:

- Create training materials, videos and eLearning solutions as required
- Advise on digital learning, interactive tools, activities and software
- Support stakeholders, staff and students as appropriate from induction to everyday support
- Train staff in video editing and voice over recording using our campus eLearning labs
- Contribute to the development of the College's teaching, learning and Assessment strategy, while working with the Learning Technologist Manager
- Work with Programme Directors and Lecturers to ensure that online and blended course development is closely integrated with all facets of academic programmes
- Promote use of innovative teaching methodology, keeping across sectoral developments
- Develop innovative approaches to teaching and learning online e.g. use of ePortfolios
- Work with the lecturers to ensure that our VLE (Moodle) is optimised to promote student engagement e.g. use of learning analytics for learner success
- Contribute to the planning and development of new programmes and the roll-out of digital modes of delivery on existing programmes, while being mindful of GDPR compliance
