**An example of Academic Study Form**

During first 2 weeks of term (starting on Monday, 21<sup>st</sup> of September 2020), students can attend as many classes as they want to find out which modules they want to follow.

No later than **Thursday, 1<sup>st</sup> of October 2020**, students need to submit their 'Academic Study Form' listing modules of their choice to the International Office.

After submitting the Academic Study Form to the International Office, students will be registered for the modules listed on the Academic Study Form. Once registered, students will be receiving access to Moodle (Griffith College Intranet). Please be advised that the registration make take 2-3 days.



## **I have already submitted my Academic Study Form to the International Office, but I would like to change my module/modules now. Can I do that?**

Once you submit an Academic Study Form to the International Office, you cannot change your modules.

## **Should I choose modules from one faculty only?**

Please be advised that students can choose modules across different faculties, subject to approval of home institution.

## **How many modules can I choose if I am a Gap Programme student?**

It depends on student's English language level.

Students who do not hold an English proficiency certificate (TOIEC, TOEFL, IELTS, etc.) can take Griffith College's in-house English language test in January, prior to commencement of the academic year.

Please see below how a given level of English corresponds to number of modules that Gap Programme student can take:

<b>IELTS score requirement</b>	<b>No. of modules per semester</b>
6.5 or above	4 modules per semester
5 or above	2 modules +15 hrs of English language
5 or below	English language only

<i>Griffith College Placement Test</i>	<i>No. of modules per semester</i>
B2+/C1/C2	4 modules
B2	2 modules +15 hrs of English language
Below B2	English Language only

Please be advised that Gap Programme students can choose modules across different faculties, but from year 1 only.

## **How many modules should I choose per semester?**

Normally study abroad students select 4-5 modules per semester, totalling an equivalent of 30 ECTS credits.
