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Information Regarding Semester 1 Exams

In the light of recent COVID infection rates and to ensure your programme is delivered on-campus and in-person during semester two, the college has decided that **January end-of-semester examinations will be held online rather than on campus.**

For those of you who are attending classes on campus, teaching will continue on-campus unless changes are required by government for public health reasons.

The timetable for examinations remains unchanged.

Further details of the college's online proctoring system have been communicated to all learners.

Please find below updated information on the College's teaching and learning plans for semester two.

Health & Safety

- All learners must continue to wear a mask at all times while indoors, including when seated at their desks.
- We encourage the regular use of hand sanitiser, which is available throughout the campus.
- If you have any COVID-19 symptoms, do not come to campus, and contact your doctor for advice - If anyone living in your household has tested positive for COVID-19, you must restrict your movements for five days. You should also take three antigen tests over the course of the five days, and if they all show up negative, you can stop restricting your movements at the end of the five-day period and return to physical classes.

Teaching

- Physical classes, practical labs and tutorials will continue as normal and in-person as per your timetable.
- These classes will continue to be limited to 80% of the maximum room capacity.
- All online classes will continue as normal.
- Learners are encouraged to speak with their faculty about any specific learning concerns.
