Applicants for this position should have an established track record in reporting, ideally for national press. Experience of court reporting is an advantage but not strictly necessary.

You will demonstrate a high degree of personal initiative and good judgement. The capacity to work both independently and as part of a team and to work with the various elements of the criminal justice system is essential.

This is a short term contract position beginning on April 26th and running until July 31, inclusive (subject to any unforeseeable future lock down of the courts due to Covid-19 public health guidelines). The successful candidate will be ideally available to work Monday to Friday but this may be up for negotiation, subject to getting the right person for the job. The successful candidate will be paid a per diem rate.
